

# Sins in detail

### Adultery (μοιχεία – moicheia, G3430)

**Thayer Definition:** 1) adultery

**Part of Speech:** noun feminine

**Related Word:** from G3431

**Modern context:** Breaking marital vows through affairs, often through emotional or physical connections at work, travel, or in close-knit social circles.

### Harlotry (πορνεία – porneia, G4202)

**Thayer Definition:** 1) illicit sexual intercourse 1a) adultery, fornication, homosexuality, lesbianism, intercourse with animals etc. 1b) sexual intercourse with close relatives; Lev. 18 1c) sexual intercourse with a divorced man or woman; Mar 10:11-12 2) metaphorically the worship of idols 2a) of the defilement of idolatry, as incurred by eating the sacrifices offered to idols

## Uncleanness (ἀκαθαρσία – akatharsia, G167)

## Lewdness (ἀσέλγεια – aselgeia, G766)

## Sorcery (φαρμακεία – pharmakeia, G5331)

## Hatreds (ἔχθρα – echthra, G2189)

### **Envies (φθόνος – phthonos, G5355)**

**Modern context:** Resentment toward others' achievements, leading to subtle sabotage.

### **Fond of Themselves (φίλαυτος – philautos, G5367)**

**Modern context:** Self-centered priorities that neglect family or community needs.

### **Fond of Money (φιλάργυρος – philarguros, G5366)**

**Thayer Definition:** 1) loving money, avarice

**Part of Speech:** adjective

**Related Word:** from G5384 and G696

**Modern context:** Greed driving dishonest business practices or financial exploitation.

### **Ostentatious (ἀλαζών – alazōn, G213)**

**Thayer Definition:** 1) an empty pretender, a boaster

**Part of Speech:** noun masculine

**Related Word:** from ale (vagrancy)

**Modern context:** Exaggerated self-promotion to impress others in social or professional circles.

### **Proud (ὑπερήφανος – hyperēphanos, G5244)**

**Modern context:** Superficial religious observance without genuine transformation. Outwardly religious people with no substance.

### Frauds (κλοπή – klopē, G2829)

**Thayer Definition:** 1) theft

**Part of Speech:** noun feminine

**Modern context:** Dishonest gain through cheating or stealing.

### Desires for Wealth (πλεονεξία – pleonexia, G4124)

### **Wickedness (πονηρία – ponēria, G4189)**
